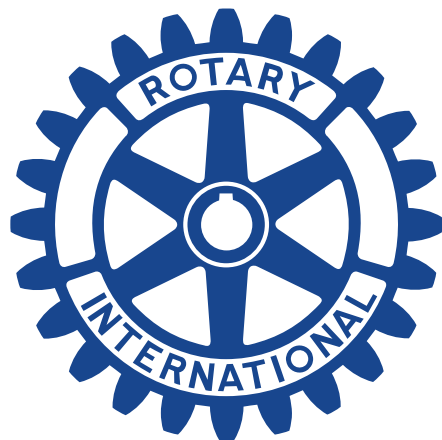

- 4)** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

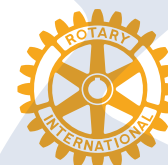
